Feast

On 22 April 1541, the Founding Fathers of the Society of Jesus made their solemn profession of vows in the newly instituted Order, during the celebration of Mass at Our Lady's altar in the basilica of St Paul Outside-the-Walls in Rome. It was a crowning event in the history of the Society of Jesus. Today's feast commemorates the birth of the vowed Society and its dedication to Mary as its Mother.

Entrance Antiphon

When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple standing there whom he loved, he said to his mother, "Woman, behold, your son." Then he said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother."

The Gloria in excelsis (Glory to God in the highest) is said.

Collect

Almighty ever-living God, whose Only Begotten Son, as he hung upon the Cross, made the Blessed Virgin Mary, his Mother, our Mother as well, grant, we pray, that with the assistance of her love, the least Society of Jesus, whose companions vow themselves to you in her presence, may serve your majesty in obedience and follow your Son perfectly. Who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.

Prayer over the Offerings

O God, receive the oblation we offer to your divine Majesty, and, as you united Mary to the cross and glory of your Son, turn our eyes toward him whom we have pierced, so that, seeking his Kingdom on earth, we may come to eternal life with Mary, our Mother. Through Christ our Lord.

May God, through the prayers of Mary, Virgin and Mother, who gave the world the author of life, protect you always.

May God be pleased to grant all of you, as you celebrate with faith the feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary, health of body and consolation of spirit.

R/. Amen.

And may the blessing of almighty God, the Father, and the Son, + and the Holy Spirit, come down on you and remain with you for ever. R/. Amen
