Saint Peter Canisius, Priest and Doctor of the Church

Memorial

Peter Canisius (1521-1597) was born in Nijmegen, the Netherlands. He entered the Society of Jesus in 1543, the first Dutchman to do so. In 1547 he served as theological consultant at the Council of Trent. In 1548 he was assigned to the first Jesuit school in Messina. In 1549 he was sent to teach at the University of Ingolstadt, Germany. In 1552, he was transferred to Vienna, where he did pastoral ministries and began writing his famous *Catechism*. In 1556, he was appointed Provincial Superior of the newly created Upper German Province. Canisius was one of the giants of the young Society of Jesus. He is honoured as a Doctor of the Church for his heroic defense of Catholicism through teaching, preaching and writing.
