Saint Robert Bellarmine, Bishop and Doctor of the Church

Memorial

Robert Bellarmine (1542-1621) in Montepulciano, Italy, and entered the Society of Jesus in 1560. After he was ordained a priest in 1570, he was appointed as the first Jesuit professor of theology at the newly-opened college at Louvain. He soon obtained a reputation as a professor a preacher. In 1576 he was entrusted with the Chair of Controversies recently founded at the Roman College, where he taught theology. His lectures were published in three volumes bearing the title *De Controversiis*. His teaching was aimed at responding to the objections against the Catholic Church by the Reformers – Luther and Calvin. He is considered as an outstanding theologian of his age.
