Fr. Alexandre Mohl

Son of the Count of Mohl, he was born on October 9, 1864, in exile in Ufa, Siberia. He studied for the diocesan clergy and was ordained priest on November 1, 1891. Shortly after the ordination, he entered the Society of Jesus on November 1, 1891, in Poland. He went to the Zambezia Mission (Mozambique) in 1901, where he worked in Boroma until 1902. He returned to his Province for health reasons. He took his final vows on February 2, 1905. He was known as a theologian and linguist. He died in Krakow on January 1, 1913. He published the following works: *Prktisch grammatik der Bantu – sprache von Tete, eine dialekt des Uter-Sambesi mit varianten der Sena – sprache und woerterbuch,* Krakau, 1904.
