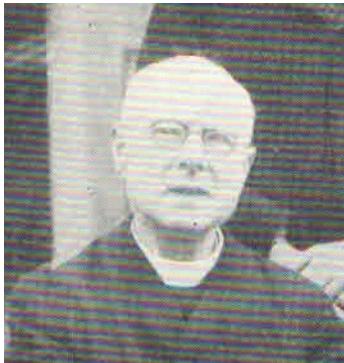

Fr CUTHBERT MEYER 19 February 1868 – 15 January 1958



Cuthbert Meyer was born into a tailoring family in London which made clothes for the royals. He was at school at Mount St Mary's, the Jesuit school, near Sheffield, and entered the Society in 1886.

Ordained in 1902, he was in St Aidan's from 1903-11, but his obituary says nothing about these years.

He returned to England in 1911 and worked in Bristol until 1934 apart from the war years when he was a chaplain to the armed forces.

In 1934 he went to Beaumont College as Spiritual Father. He had various other postings and ended as a parish visitor in Roehampton, based at Manresa novitiate. He died a month short of his ninetieth birthday.
