Fr. Félix DESMAROUX

Born in Dompierre, Allier, France, on June 3, 1858, he entered the Society of Jesus on September 24, 1876. He went to the Zambezia Mission (Mozambique) in 1889, where he lived and worked in Quelimane. From Quelimane, he assisted the missions of Coalane and Chupanga. He professed his final vows on February 02, 1894, in Quelimane. He died in Boroma on February 28, 1898, on his way to the mission of Miruro, Zumbo, for which he had been appointed superior. He left a manuscript grammar of the Echuabo language, spoken in Quelimane.
