He was born in Osenbach, Upper Rhine (Alsace), France, on July 11, 1859 and entered the Society of Jesus on April 20, 1880. He did his tertianship in Setubal (1892 - 1893). Then, he was sent to the Zambezia Mission (Moçambique), in 1893. He also worked in Inhambane, Coalane and Chupanga,, as well as he was in charge of the missionary station of Caia. He took his final vows in 1894. He died on March 20 or 21, 1897, in Caia. He published *Les maladies de l'Afrique tropical*, Bruxelles, 1892.
