He was born in Augsburg, Bavaria, Germany, on November 15, 1860 and entered the Society of Jesus on July 14, 1882 in the Austrian Province. He studied philosophy at the Dunbrody College in South Africa and did his theology at the formation house of the English Province on the island of Jersey. He was ordained priest on July 31, 1892, in Dublin. He did his tertianship in Setúbal and left for the Zambezia Mission (Mozambique), in 1893. There, he worked in the mission of São Pedro Claver do Ricico, in Zumbo, where he professed his final vows on April 15, 1894. He died on March 21, 1895, in Ricico.
