Br ANDREW MAGANZINI

30 November 1839 – 21 March 1915



Andrew Maganzini, born near Trentino, entered the novitiate in Chieri, Italy, in 1881, aged forty-two. Three years later we find him in Dunbrody and in 1885 at St Aidan's. He then moved to Portuguese East Africa (Quelimane, Mozambique) in 1886 and finally to Graaf Reinet in 1887 before returning to Italy in 1889

as his health could not take the climate.

Besides these bare details, there is one reference to him in the archives where Fr Andrew Hartmann mentions him as a 'good and guileless soul' at Quelimane where he was cook and factotum. The picture shows the cathedral built in Quelimane between 1890 and 1910

Born in Saint Giusta in Trentino, Italy, on November 30, 1839, he entered the Society of Jesus on August 14, 1881. He worked in the Lower Zambezia (Mozambique) in 1885 and 1886. He took his final vows on August 15, 1893. He died on March 21, 1915, in Chieri, Italy.
