7 April 1855 – 22 March 1893



Besides having a card in the archives with the barest details, we really know next to nothing about Thomas Manning. Born in Dingle, Ireland, (see picture) he came out to teach at St Aidan's in 1882 as a scholastic and did his theology at Dunbrody from 1887. By 1890 he was back at St Aidan's where he 'overtaxed' himself

and died of consumption (TB) three years later. He was 38.
