He was born in A dos Ruivos, Bombarral, on October 28, 1869 and entered the Society of Jesus on August 27, 1895. He took his final vows on February 2, 1906, in Setúbal. He went to the Zambezia Mission (Mozambique) in 1908. He worked in the Coalane Mission. He left Mozambique for Europe in 1913. In Europe, he worked at Nun'Alvres Institute in Jette-St-Pierre, Belgium, in the Tertianship Community in Murcia, then in Oya, Spain. In Portugal, he lived and worked at Nun' Alvres Institute, in Caldas da Saúde and Santo Tirso, where he died on April 2, 1955.
