Br. José António MARTINS

Born in Felgar, Moncorvo- Portugal, on January 18, 1877, he entered the Society of Jesus on August 31, 1898, in Barro. He lived in Setúbal but he used to take care of the vegetables garden in Vale do Rosal. In 1907, he was sent to the Zambezia Mission (Mozambique) where he worked in the mission of São Pedro Clavier in Miruro, Zumbo. He also worked in the mission of the Immaculate Conception of Chupanga. He took his final vows on September 9, 1911, in Chupanga. He left Mozambique in 1912 and died in Jette-St-Pierre, Brussels, on April 11, 1913.
