Fr. Luís LOPES

He was born in Louriçal do Campo, Castelo Branco, on January 07, 1867 and entered the Society of Jesus on September 20, 1882. He studied philosophy in Setubal and did his regency in Campolide. He studied theology in Oña, Burgos, Spain, where he was ordained priest on July 30, 1898. He did his tertianship in Manresa and took his final vows on February 2, 1900, in São Fiel. He went to the Zambezia Mission (Mozambique) in 1904 and worked in the mission of São Pedro Clavier, in Miruro, until 1910. He went to Brazil where he lived in the residence of Santo António da Barra and at Colégio António Vieira. He died in Baía, on May 05, 1954.
