Fr. Eugénio WITZ

Born in Meisengott, Bas-Rhin, in the region of Alsace, France, on March 30, 1874, he entered the Society of Jesus on September 14, 1894, at Barro. He studied philosophy at São Fiel. He did his regency in Quelimane, Mozambique from 1898 to 1901. He studied theology in Setúbal. Then, he did his tertianship in Barro. He returned to Mozambique and professed his final vows on February 25, 1907, in Quelimane. He was appointed superior of the mission of Boroma in 1909. He left Mozambique in 1914. In Europe, he worked as chaplain of a hospital during the First World War and, in 1919, he was sent to Nun' Alvres Institute in La Guardia and then to Caldas da Saúde. He died in Soutelo on May 18, 1953.
