Fr PETER DICHAMPS

15 February 1854 – 11 June 1911

Born in Servieres in France, Peter Dichamps entered the Society in 1874. By 1886 he was at St Aidan's and the following year was rector at Dunbrody where he taught philosophy. His community had four priests, three theologians nineteen philosophers and ten brothers. When Dunbrody was closed as a



philosophate, he went to England where he taught philosophy at Stonyhurst until his death in 1911.
