**Fr. António NUNES**

Born in Louriçal do Campo, Castelo Branco-Portugal, on July 5, 1869, he entered the Society of Jesus on September 7, 1887, in Barro. He studied humanities and the first year of philosophy in Setúbal and finished these studies at Colégio de São Fiel. He did his regency at Colégio de Campolide. He studied two years of theology (1899 - 1901) in Enghien, Belgium and did the third year at Colégio de São Fiel. He was ordained priest on July 30, 1902, in Oña, Burgos. He went to the Zambezia Mission (Mozambique) in 1905 and took his final vows on August 15, 1906, in Quelimane. He worked in the missions of Chupanga, Boroma and Coalane. He left Mozambique in 1912 and went to Jette-St-Pierre, Brussels, where he stayed for about a year. He went to Brazil, living and working at Colégio António Vieira, in Baía, until 1923. Then, he was involved in apostolic ministries in the residence of Pará. He died at Colégio António Vieira, in Baía, on June 15, 1938.
