## Br. Simeão Neves dos SANTOS

He was born in Freiria dos Chapéus, Torres Vedras-Portugal, on 05 January 1926 and entered the Society of Jesus on 07 September 1949, at the convent of Santa Marinha da Costa, Guimarães. After his novitiate, he was assigned to live in the community Colégio de São João de Brito, where he worked as minister, cook, steward, nurse and driver. In 1973, he was sent to Mozambique where he worked at the mission of São Benedito da Manga, Beira, as a home nurse, cook, and driver, among other tasks. After Mozambique's independence, he worked in a Secondary School in the same city. In 1979, he returned to Portugal where he worked at Santo André (Sines) and, in 1980, he was sent to São João de Brito's College where he worked in the Physics and Chemistry laboratories, while studying electricity. He returned to Mozambique in 1983 and stayed in Satémwa. In 1987, he moved to Beira, Matacuane's residence. There, he took care of the house and had his own workshop for mechanics and locksmiths. After a work related accident, he was admitted at Beira hospital and later taken to a hospital in Johannesburg. He died on July 9, 1995, in Johannesburg, South Africa.
