He was born in Freguesia de Magueija, Concelho de Lamego, Viseu, on 07 February 1939 and entered the Society of Jesus on 14 October 1955, in Soutelo, Braga. He did his humanities' studies in Soutelo and philosophy at the Faculty of Philosophy in Braga, where he graduated in 1963. He did his regency at the College of S. João de Brito (1963 - 1966) and theology in Granada, Spain (1966 - 1970). In 1970, he went to the Vice-Province of Mozambique, where he worked at the mission of Fonte Boa as director of the "Azevedo Coutinho" College. In 1975, he returned to Portugal and was assigned to work at Colégio São João de Brito, where he worked as a teacher. In 1981, he stopped teaching due to health problems. He continued living at João de Brito's College and co-ordinated, for some time, sporting activities. He was a librarian and took part in liturgy helping with the songs. He also worked in the translation and revision of texts, at the request of the Provincial Curia. He was a faithful and dedicated Jesuit. He had a great spirit of sacrifice. He passed away on 20 July 2016, in Lisbon.
