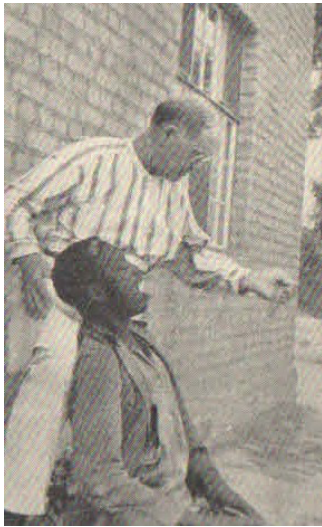

Br PAUL GENCEWIEZE

14 January 1873 – 10 August 1942

For virtually all Jesuits on the Zambezi Mission there is some information but for many there are no photos. For Paul there are photos but hardly any information. He entered the Society in 1895 and served in Chishawasha (from 1902), Driefontein (1914), Mzondo (1921), Bikita and Driefonytein (!922), Musami (1935) and Umtali (Mutare). He died in Salisbury. He



was described as cheerful, indefatigable and a lover of practical jokes.

Nigel Johnston was not the first dentist at Musami! Br Paul was there before him.
