## Fr. Honório das Neves SANTOS

He was born in Lugar de Sendeira, Freguesia de Freiria, Concelho de Torres Vedras-Portugal, on 08 July 1936 and entered the Society of Jesus on 07 September 1955, in Soutelo, Braga. He studied Humanities in Soutelo and Philosophy in the Faculty of Philosophy, in Braga (1960 -1963). He did his regency in the Zambézia mission (Mozambique). He spent one year in Fonte Boa and two years in Boroma, where he worked as dean of studies and teacher at the Teacher Training School. He studied theology at San Cugat del Vallés, Barcelona (1966 - 1970). He was ordained priest on June 29, 1969, at the Cathedral in Lisbon. He was a military chaplain in Angola. In 1973, he returned to Mozambique and worked in the mission of Fonte Boa as well as he was responsible for St. Ignatius mission in Msaladzi. He took his final vows on the 15th August 1975, in Fonte Boa. In 1984, he was appointed superior of Satémwa and parish priest of Fonte Boa. In 1987, he was sent to Tete from where he was also responsible for the pastoral zone of Angónia. In 1989, he went to work as parish priest in Beira at Matacuane Parish. In 1991, he was appointed superior and started many small schools in the outskirts of the parish. In 1997, he returned for good to Portugal where he was appointed superior, bursar and parish priest. He undertook intense apostolic activities. He passed away on 31 August 2014, in Lisbon.
