Born in Figueiró da Serra, in Concelho de Gouveia, on December 29th, 1869, he entered the Society of Jesus on July 17th, 1893, in Barro. He went to Zambezia Mission (Mozambique) in 1897. He worked in the mission of Imaculada Conceição in Chupanga, as a famous master shoemaker. He took his final vows on August 15, 1904, in Chupanga. He left Mozambique in 1914. He lived in Jette-St-Pierre, at Nun'Alvres College, Brussels, and in the Apostolic School of San Martín de Trevejo, Spain. In 1925, he went, as a missionary, to China. He lived in residence in T'au-Tau. He died in Macau on October 28, 1933.
