Brás, Freguesia das Lages, Conselho da Praia da Vitória (Third Azores Island), on 26 September 1922, he entered the Society of Jesus on 07 September 1949, at the Convent of Santa Marinha da Costa, Guimarães. He took his first vows on 08 September 1951 at the College of Caldas da Saúde. He lived in Soutelo, Braga, working as a locksmith's assistant. In 1953, he was assigned to the Zambézia Mission (Mozambique) where he worked in the missions of Boroma, Chiritze, Fonte Boa and Satémwa. He always worked as a locksmith, electrician and mechanic. From 1960 to 1961, he was in Soutelo, Braga, for his tertianship and took his final vows on 02 February 1960, in Soutelo. In 1979, he returned to Portugal where he was assigned to live in Casa da Torre, Soutelo, to work as a locksmith. In 1980, he went to Instituto Nun'Alvres, Caldas da Saúde, to be in charge of the locksmiths and the carpenters. He was also responsible for the operation of the boilers of the Termas das Caldas da Saúde. In 2016, he was sent to the community of the infirmary of the Faculty of Philosophy in Braga. He passed away on the 29th of November 2017, in Braga.
